Intern in Artist Studio – General Operations

Camille Norment Studio has an opening for an intern for a period of a minimum of three months, minimum three days per week., flexible hours TBD, starting immediately. The intern we seek should be open, enthusiastic and willing to learn, fluent in English, administratively interested, practically oriented and interested in the studio's area of work.

Camille Norment Studio works internationally within the field of sound related artwork that is motivated by conceptual and social concerns, and within the field of experimental music. In this, mediums include installation, performance, sculpture, drawing, and various digital or interactive media. Research, exhibition practice, lectures and publications are also important areas of the studio practice.

Focus for this period will be on facilitating production for Camille Norment's participation three international biennials, solo and group exhibitions and new performances occurring in 2016.

The intern's job will be to support the studio leader in running the studio, including daily administrative work and related production tasks. In this position, the intern gains an opportunity to learn about art production at an international level, to communicate with international exhibition organizations, to understand functional research and practice, as well as to extend his/her own network and gain work experience.

Special positions may be created for those interns with particular skills in sound, video, digital media, and innovative materials, and for those who show particular proficiency in general studio tasks.

Internships are not paid, but the studio can support an application to NAV (praksisplass) or other relevant support schemes.
