Camille Norment on glass armonica in collaboration with Håvard Skaset on electric guitar and Vegar Vårdal on hardingfele explore the visceral qualities of resonance, overtone, and acoustic feedback through the spectral tensions of consonant and dissonant sound. Through tension and release, abrasion and delicacy, beauty and noise, the music creates a weave at the meeting points of noise, rock, improvisational, folk, and electronic music teasing the sound pallets of contemporary experimental music.

In honor of the exhibition I Wish This Was a Song, the trio will perform Glare (2012), a composition that cycles the listener through lulling and abrasive textures inspired in part by the instruments' relationships to ideas of magic and the uncanny, hypnosis and trance.
